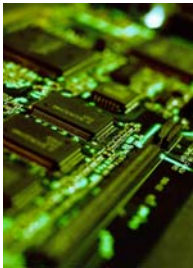

We take the time to understand your needs. Not only do we identify and recover key information such as e-

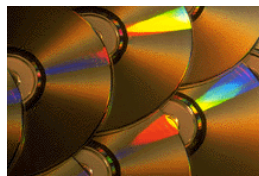

Computer Crime Investigations



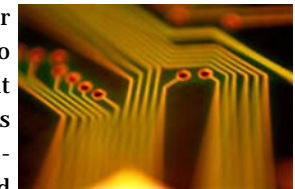
